## Appetizers choice of 3 from below

### Taboun-oven house bread, on river pebbles with green Tahini and olive oil

*“Man does not live on bread alone, but that man may live on anything that the LORD decrees” (Deuteronomy 8:3)*

### Lentil soup - warm lentil dish that will make you want to sell your “first born rights”. Served with toast on the side

*“Jacob then gave Esau bread and lentil stew; he ate and drank, and he rose and went away. Thus did Esau spurn the birthright.” (Genesis 25:34)*

### Figs stuffed with lamb meat

### Sliced salmon baked with citrus marinade, gella and sesame seeds

## Main dishes

### “Korban Pesach”

#### Lamb neck on a bed of bitter herbs, fennel and shallot onions

*“They shall eat the flesh that same night; they shall eat it roasted over the fire, with unleavened bread and with bitter herbs.” (Exodus 12:8)*

### “Par ben bakar”

#### Asado slices baked with plum sauce

*“Every day, for seven days, you shall present a goat of sin offering, as well as a bull of the herd and a ram of the flock.” (Ezeikēl 43:25)*

### Pullet with onion and sumac spice

*“A wind from the LORD started up, swept quail from the sea and strewed them over the camp, about a day’s journey..all around the camp, and some two cubits deep on the ground.” (Numbers 11:31)*

## Side dishes choice of 2 from below

### Love latke - sweet potato, leek, zucchini, and savory fried lentils

*“She took dough and kneaded it into cakes in front of him, and cooked the cakes.” (Samuel II 13:8)*

### Freekeh - toasted wheat berries with carrot and onion

*He handed her roasted grain, and she ate her fill and had some left over. (Ruth 2:14)*

### Jasmine rice with apricot and fresh herbs

*“You shall also give him the first fruits of your new grain and wine and oil, and the first shearing of your sheep.” (Deuteronomy 18:4)*
